

Sample Salvation Prayer for Children

I am going to demonstrate what a prayer to Jesus sounds like. If you would like to pray along with me, then this prayer can become your prayer.

Dear God, Thank you for loving me so much even though I don't always make the right choices. I have done some things that are bad and I'm ashamed of that. Jesus please forgive me of these sins. Say the following to the child(ren)...

I have some pictures to show you, but watch and listen closely because they show us something very exciting. (hold up Gospel Flip Tract)

This first picture says, **THE DESIGN**

What is the picture showing? (heart)

It says...**God wants to be our best friend forever!**

Did you know that God loves you with all his heart and he wants you to love him back with all your heart? That is God's design for every person he ever created.

There is also a Bible Verse on the top that we can look up. (for older kids)

Okay, now I am going to open up the picture to display a new picture. (fold open all the way to back)




This picture says, **THE PROBLEM**

What is the picture showing? (heart with dirty splotches)

It says...**Everyone makes bad choices sometimes.**

Everyone has done bad things that the Bible calls sin. This sin makes us feel dirty inside. This is a problem because God cannot be around sin.

There is another Bible Verse that we can look up.




Okay, now I am going to flip over (top to bottom) the picture to display another picture.

This picture says, **THE SOLUTION**

What is the picture showing? (a cross)

It says...**Jesus took the punishment for my mistakes.**

There is another Bible Verse that we can look up.

Okay, one last time, I am going to open up the picture to display a final picture. (fold open all the way to back just like before)

This one says, **THE CHOICE**

What is the picture showing? (two friends hugging)

It says...**Ask Jesus for forgiveness and you'll be a friend of God forever!**

We can ask Jesus to forgive us of every bad things and then our sin is gone and we can be with God forever! Is that a choice you would like to make today?

There is a final Bible Verse that we can look up.
